Medium Pot Recommendations

Please note that many of the varieties listed here can also be found under different headings such as “*Small Pots*” and others will be found under “*Cut Flowers*”. These varieties will respond to cultural practices such as Bonzi use for small pots or the use of shading for cut flowers.

Several of these varieties can also be used for large containers. If you are designing a large container or patio pot program, please take special note of the “pot size” category on the Tech Sheets and select only those marked as suitable for large containers.

In general, the production of medium and large pots of callas is less difficult than the production of small pots. Consequently, the grower new to potted calla production is best advised to start with the production of medium or large pots. However, it should be noted that particularly large pots can remain too wet for long durations due to their substantial soil volume. Thus, one should consider increasing porosity in very large pots, so roots may maintain optimal health.
